- Welcome, Invocation and Pledges: Judge Lovell called the meeting to order and led the opening prayer. Following the Prayer Judge Lovell led the Pledge of Allegiance to the American Flag and the Texas Flag.
- (2) Recognition and comments from guests: None
- (3) Consider approving budget amendments. Commissioner Kitchen moved to approve the Budget Amendments. Commissioner Lovell seconded. Motion carried 5 to 0.

- (4) Receive information, announcements and reports from County Departments. None
- (5) Consider approving salaries for new and/or transfer employees. **None.**
- (6) Commissioner Lovell made a motion to approve payment of compensatory, and vacation time for County Employees and necessary budget amendments by paying Delman Orme, HCSO \$210.99. Commissioner Henderson seconded. Motion carried 5 o 0.
- (7) Discuss and consider rescinding the authorization for the contract with D & F Med LLC dba Groveton Family Medical Clinic for Inmate Health Services at the Houston County Jail.
 Commissioner Kitchen made this in the form of a motion and Commissioner Henderson seconded. Motion carried 5 to 0.
- (8) Commissioner Lovell made a motion to authorize the County Judge and the County Sheriff to sign a contract with Merci LLC dba Alto Family Medical Clinic for Inmate Health Services at the Houston County Jail. Commissioner Henderson seconded. Motion carried 5 to 0.
- (9) Discuss and consider action on a 2021 Mack Dump Truck for Precinct 2 from East Texas Mack through TIPS Purchasing Co-op for \$132,000.00.

(a) participation in the East Texas Mack Municipal Buy Back Program with guaranteed buy back amount of \$120,000 after 13 months. **Commissioner Kitchen so moved and Commissioner Henderson seconded. Motion carried 5 to 0.**

(b) authorize lease purchase agreement with Citizens National Bank for the purchase of Dump Truck, collateralize with CD in the amount of \$132,000.00 and necessary budget amendments. **Commissioner Kitchen made this in the form of a motion and designated himself and Judge Lovell as the signers. Commissioner Henderson seconded. Motion carried 5 to 0.**

- (10)Commissioner Kitchen made a motion to enter a contract with Rebekah L. Bear to purchase and remove from her property 2,500 yards of recycled road material for Precinct 2. Commissioner Lovell seconded. Motion carried 5 to 0.
- (11)Adjourn. Judge Lovell made the motion to adjourn. Commissioner Henderson seconded. Motion carried 5 to 0.
