(1) Welcome, Invocation and Pledges:

Commissioner Kitchen called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m. Commissioner Stokes gave the Invocation and Commissioner Kitchen lead the Pledge to the American Flag and the Texas Flag.

**Judge Lovell entered the meeting at 9:02 a.m.

- (2) Recognition and comments from guests. (For informational purposes only, with no deliberation and no action taken, except that the Court may discuss whether to include any matter on a future agenda for deliberation and/or action.) Judge Lovell offered up Praise for John Jeter (Auditor's husband) and the great recovery he is experiencing since his surgery. Judge Lovell also shared that Todd's (IT) dad is in critical care following surgery and ask for prayer. He also reminded us to keep the family, friends, and co-workers of Jason Lowery in our prayers following his unexpected death.
- (3) Consider approval of prior Commissioners Court minutes. Commissioner Lovell made a motion to approve the Commissioners Court minutes for April 9, 2024 and April 12, 2024.

 Commissioner Henderson seconded. Motion carried 5 to 0.
- (4) Consider approving budget amendments. NONE
- (5) Consider payment of bills and expenses:
 - a. Accounts payable
 - b. Fund transfers
 - c. Ratify Salary expenses

Commissioner Lovell made a motion to pay all the bills and expenses for a. (Accounts payable), b. (Fund transfers), and c. (Ratify Salary expenses). The motion was seconded by Commissioner Kitchen. The Motion carried 5 to 0.

- (6) Receive information, announcements and reports from County Departments:
 - a. County Treasurers Report
 - b. Compensatory Report
 - c. Financial Report Auditor

Commissioner Kitchen moved to receive the County Treasurers Report, Compensatory Report, and Financial Report - Auditor as information. Commissioner Henderson seconded. Motion carried 5 to 0.

*Judge Lovell reminded everyone about the County Picnic on April 26, 2024 at Noon. He shared that Bane Equipment/Byron Underwood and Tiger Worsham/Perdue Brandon will be grilling and serving up the burgers.

*Sheriff Hargrove gave an update on the inmate that is hospitalized. Until inmate is released from hospital Sheriff is only sending one security officer and has conveyed the same information to Badgehire. The DA is aware of the situation and is working on this pending case.

- (7) Consider approving salaries for new and/or transfer employees.
 - Part-time Deputy Clerk, Tax Assessor Collector's Office Commissioner Kitchen made a
 motion to approve the salary of Tena Smith as Part-time Deputy Clerk in the Tax
 Assessor Collector's Office at the hourly rate of \$15.21 in Pay Grade 16, effective May
 1, 2024. Commissioner Henderson seconded. Motion carried 5 to 0.
 - b. Legal Assistant, Six months raise in salary, County Attorney's Office Commissioner
 Kitchen made a motion to approve the six month salary raise of Litzy Cruz in the
 County Attorney's Office raising her bi-weekly pay from \$1,180.30 to \$1,239.32 in Pay
 Grade 15. Commissioner Stokes seconded. Motion carried 5 to 0.

- c. Part-time Clerk, Justice of the Peace Precinct 1 Office Commissioner Lovell made a motion to approve the Transfer of Elizabeth Bridges to Part-time Clerk in the Justice of the Peace Office Precinct 1 at hourly pay of \$13.14 in Pay Grade 13, effective April 8, 2024. Commissioner Kitchen seconded. Motion carried 5 to 0.
- (8) Discuss and consider approving payment of compensatory, and vacation time for County employees and necessary budget amendments. Commissioner Kitchen made a motion and Commissioner Stokes seconded to approve compensatory payment to Jerrod Vickers, Comm Supervisor, in the amount of \$298.90, and Rocky Hoch, Transport Deputy, in the amount of \$124.68, because they are over the accrued compensatory limit. Motion carried 5 to 0.
- (9) Discuss and consider declaring received information as surplus inventory and approving transfers between departments. **NONE**
- (10) Hear a presentation from Gene Kellum on the quarterly report for Houston County Search and Rescue. Gene Kellum shared that things are going well with Search and Rescue. They have gained 32 new members this quarter. They are excited about getting some new equipment that will aid them in their search and rescue operations. They have had 2 cases this year that both resulted in successful recoveries.

Commissioner Kitchen voiced concerns about damage to roads in Precinct 2 and Spectrum's unwillingness to do anything about the damage. No action was taken on this item.
- (14) Discuss and consider action on application for the Hotel Occupancy Tax Fund and agreement with Montoya Enterprises LLC for the Davy Crockett Classic Bike Race to be held May 4-5, 2024 and necessary budget amendments. Commissioner Kitchen made a motion approve \$2,000 on application for the Hotel Occupancy Tax Fund and agreement with Montoya Enterprises LLC for the Davy Crockett Classic Bike Race to be held May 4-5, 2024 and necessary budget amendments. Commissioner Henderson seconded. Motion carried 5 to 0.

Commissioner Kitchen made a motion to accept a donation of 1000 yards of iron ore/clay mix from Tommy Sprinkle valued at \$2 per yard in Precinct 2. Commissioner Stokes seconded. Motion carried 5 to 0.
