Amber Stelly, and Commissioner Kitchen nominated Jimmy Gaines. Commissioner Henderson was not present, but was called on the phone, and he said that the persons he spoke to did not want to serve and he did not have any other names. This is the reason that Commissioner Kitchen made a second nomination. Commissioner Lovell moved to approve the nominations of Barrett Riess, Randy Parten, John A. McCall, Amber Stelly, and Jimmy Gaines to serve on the Ground Water Conservation District Development Committee. Commissioner Stokes seconded. Motion carried 4 to 0.

- (3) Discuss and consider the engagement of an attorney to provide legal assistance to Houston County during its development of a GWCD. Commissioner Stokes made a motion to employ attorney, Adam Friedman, that the County has already hired as legal counsel to represent us in the current battle, and expand his scope of work to include providing legal assistance to Houston County during its development of a GWCD.
