Commissioner Henderson seconded. Motion carried 4 to 0.

- (29)Conduct Public Hearing on Proposed Budget for Fiscal Year 2024. Judge Lovell opened the Public Hearing on Proposed Budget for Fiscal Year 2024 at 10:06 a.m. Judge Lovell closed the Public Hearing on Proposed Budget for Fiscal Year 2024 at 10:07 a.m.
- (30)Conduct Public Hearing on Proposed Tax Rate for Fiscal Year 2024. Judge Lovell opened the Public Hearing at 10:07 a.m. after there was no response Judge Lovell closed the Public Hearing at 10:08 a.m.
- (31) Discuss and consider adopting the Houston County Budget for Fiscal Year 2024. Commissioner Lovell made a motion to adopt the Houston County Budget for Fiscal Year 2024. Commissioner Stokes seconded. Roll call vote:

Commissioner Henderson made a motion to adopt FY 2023 County Tax Rate of \$0.448000 that includes the Maintenance and Operations Tax Rate of \$0.394448 and Interest and Sinking Tax Rate of \$0.053552. Commissioner Stokes seconded. Motion carried 4 to 0.

(33)Discuss and ratify the increase of property tax revenue by 6.84% in the FY 2024 Budget. **Judge**Lovell moved that the property tax rate be increased by the adoption of a tax rate of .448000,

which is effectively a 6.84% increase in the tax rate. Commissioner Henderson seconded. Motion carried 4 to 0.

- (34) Discuss and consider setting salaries for all officers and employees of Houston County for Fiscal Year 2024. Commissioner Lovell made a motion to set salaries for all officers and employees of Houston County for Fiscal Year 2024 as presented. Commissioner Henderson seconded.

  Motion carried 4 to 0.
- (35)Adjourn. Judge Lovell made a motion for the Commissioners Court Meeting to Adjourn. The motion carried by everyone rising and leaving the meeting at 10:17 a.m.
