## (1) Welcome, Invocation and Pledges:

Judge Lovell called the meeting to order at 10:01 a.m. Commissioner Kitchen voiced the opening prayer followed by Judge Lovell leading the Pledge of Allegiance to the American Flag and the Texas Flag.

- (2) Discuss and consider granting a discretionary exemption from the competitive bid process to contract for air conditioning/heating units, replacement and repairs at the "Permanent Records Storage (previously known as the Old Jail)" to preserve the records and property of the County, LGC §262.024 (1).   - a. a contract with Hargrove-Neel to replace 4 air conditioning/heating units, repair 1 unit and update all current units with hail guards, fresh air dampers and curb adapters at the Old County Jail building.

Commissioner Henderson made a motion to approve through the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) Grant Fund with necessary budget amendments a contract with Hargrove-Neel to replace 4 air-conditioning/heating units, repair 1 unit and update all current units with hail guards, fresh air dampers and curb adapters at the Old County Jail building.

- (4) Discuss and consider action on advertising to accept sealed bids for items to be funded through the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) Grant Fund:
  - a. Pickup Truck for Precinct 3
  - b. Pickup Truck for Constable Precinct 2 Commissioner Lovell made a motion to advertise to accept sealed bids for a Pickup Truck for Precinct 3 and Pickup Truck for Constable Precinct 2 to be funded through the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) Grant Fund. Commissioner Stokes seconded. Motion carried 5 to 0.
  - c. Replacement Roof and gutter system at Armory
  - d. Updated Camera System for Jail
    Commissioner Lovell moved to advertise to accept sealed bids for replacement roof
    and gutter system at Armory and Updated Camera System for Jail to be funded
    through the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) Grant Fund. Commissioner Henderson
    seconded. Motion carried 5 to 0.
- (5) Adjourn. At 10:07 a.m., Judge Lovell made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Commissioner Henderson seconded. Motion carried 5 to 0.
