- (1) Welcome, Invocation and Pledges:
 - Commissioner Lovell called the meeting to order at **10:00** a.m. Commissioner Lovell voiced the opening prayer followed by leading the Pledge of Allegiance to the American Flag and the Texas Flag.
- (2) Discuss and consider action on authorizing the following items through the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) Grant Fund and necessary budget amendments:

- a. Purchase and authorize payment for Constable Precinct 2 from received bids a 2022 ½ Ton Crew Cab, 4WD, Automatic, Pickup. Commissioner Stokes made a motion to approve purchase and authorize payment for Constable Precinct 2 from received bids a 2022 ½ Ton Crew Cab, 4WD, Automatic, Pickup and amend budget by transferring \$32,000 from Transport Vehicle Fund and \$22,200 from Road and Bridge Radios to pay for pickup. Commissioner Henderson seconded. Motion carried 3 to 0.
- b. Purchase and authorize payment for Road & Bridge Precinct 3 from received bids a 2022 ½ Ton Crew Cab, 4WD, Automatic, Pickup. Commissioner Stokes moved to approve purchase and authorize payment for Road & Bridge Precinct 3 from received bids a 2022 ½ Ton Crew Cab, 4WD, Automatic, Pickup and to amend the budget by transferring funds of \$50,000 from previously approved ARPA funds and \$4,200 from Precinct 3 equipment fund and approve purchase for all vehicles. Commissioner Henderson seconded. Motion carried 3 to 0.
- (3) Adjourn. At 10:07 a.m., Commissioner Lovell made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Commissioner Stokes seconded. Motion carried 5 to 0.
