Commissioner Lovell made a motion to approve the Part-time to Full-time promotion of Kane Leos as Jailer at biweekly salary of \$1,538.46 in Pay Grade 17, effective December 10, 2024. Commissioner Henderson seconded. Motion carried 4 to 0.

Sheriff's Office 2 full time jailers Commissioner Stokes made a motion to approve the bi-weekly salaries of Alex Long as Full-time Jailer at \$1,538.46 in Pay Grade 17 effective December 10, 2024 AND Robert Stuart as Full-time Jailer at \$1,626.92 in Pay Grade 17 effective December 10, 2024. Commissioner Henderson seconded the motion. Motion carried 4 to 0.
