## (1) Welcome, Invocation and Pledges:

Judge Lovell called the meeting to order at 11:02 a.m. Commissioner Stokes led the Opening Prayer followed by Judge Lovell leading the Pledge of Allegiance to the American Flag and the Texas Flag.

(2) Consider and authorize County Judge Jim Lovell to file notice of contest of the well permit applications of Pine Bliss, LLC and Redtown Ranch Holdings, LLC with the Neches & Trinity Valley Groundwater Conservation District and engage Allison, Bass & Magee, LLP to provide legal assistance (Judge Lovell added "if needed").

\*\*At this time Judge Lovell opened up the floor to allow those in attendance to speak. He waived the necessity of filling out a Public Participation Form.

Judge Lovell gave a brief summary of what is going on with the water situation.

Amber Stelly, General Manager at Consolidated Water was the first to speak. She shared what she knows about the situation. She encouraged everyone to 1)Send in a written contest before June 19, 2025 at 11:00 a.m. to <a href="manager@ntvgcd.org">manager@ntvgcd.org</a>, 2) we need individuals willing to go to the meeting on June 19, 2025 (location to be determined) and 3)we may need individuals to testify under oath. She concluded by saying that Consolidated Water will continue the legal fight to keep them from taking our water.

Randy Parten, Owner of Rattlesnake Ranch and 7J StockFarm, he encouraged everyone to get involved and asked our Commissioners Court to continue to fight.

Greg Chapin, Commissioner Precinct 1 Anderson County, He talked about the health of this aquifer and that it can sustain us, but not if it gets taken by other areas. He also encouraged us to write, attend the meetings, and call our State Officials.

Commissioner Stokes agreed that we should write. He encouraged us not to put our displeasure about this on Facebook because the ones we need to see this are not reading Facebook

Commissioner Lovell made a motion to authorize County Judge Jim Lovell to file notice of contest of the well permit applications of Pine Bliss, LLC and Redtown Ranch Holdings, LLC with the Neches & Trinity Valley Groundwater Conservation District and engage Allison, Bass & Magee, LLP to provide legal assistance if needed. Commissioner Henderson seconded. Motion carried 4 to 0.
